On a summer's day walk with my family, thistles emerging from the borders of a wheatfield sparked my interest.

I took many photographs and later worked on the images digitally to create the balance of colour I felt best captured the quality of the light on that day. I printed the image using archival inks on watercolour paper and later decided to embellish the work by applying hand and machine embroidery. I have developed this way of working over the last few years, taking images as far as I can to create a 3D effect and enjoying the unexpected results of combining silk threads with digital imagery.

SAIL AWAY

Stoneware Clays

This ship was inspired by illustrations in medieval manuscripts of seemingly unfeasible vessels which should never have been able to float, let alone explore the planet, sporting architectural forecastles and sterncastles that wouldn't look out of place in a city scape. They embody the thirst for knowledge of those early explorers of the unknown, as well as the sheer optimism that they would survive the trip. It has been hand-built using stoneware clays, decorated with oxides and fired in an electric kiln to 1250°C.

Lane End Farm caters for young adults from all walks of life; inner city, deprived, abused, neglected, disabled (both mentally and physically), or with learning difficulties and behavioural problems.

We help them by providing excellent outdoor farm activities and encouraging personal development through individual 'mentoring' programs.

We also provide support and accommodation in a converted stone barn called 'The Room for All Seasons' which has been specifically designed for wheelchair users, in particular, young people paralysed by spinal cord injury.
